Mary Elizabeth Lange, founder and first superior of the Oblate Sisters of Providence, in Baltimore Maryland, henceforth was known as Sister Mary. She served the Oblates in many ways. She was superior general from 1829 to 1832, and again from 1835 to 1841. She helped to nurse the sick during the Cholera Epidemic in the early 1830s and in the mid-1840s, when Sister Frances died, she took her place working as a domestic at Saint Mary's Seminary, and from 1850 – 1860 she was the novice mistress for the fledgling Oblate order, and was affectionately called Mother Mary.

Mother Mary's early life had prepared her well for the turbulence that followed the death of Fr. Joubert. She suffered violence of soul as she was buffeted by poverty and racial injustice. There was a sense of abandonment at the dwindling number of pupils and defections of her closest companions and co-workers. Yet, through it all Mother Mary never lost faith in Providence.

Mother Mary Lange practiced faith to an extraordinary degree. In fact, it was her deep faith which enabled her to persevere against all odds. To her Black brothers and sisters she gave of herself and her material possessions until she was empty of all but Jesus, whom she shared generously with all by being a living witness to his teaching. Mother Lange's life was a long one. She lived to celebrate the golden anniversary of the order. N he is an example of how we may all aspire to be. In close union with her God, she lived through disappointment and opposition until God called her to himself February 3, 1882.

María Isabel Lange, fundadora y primera superiora de las Hermanas Oblatas de la Providencia, en Baltimore, Maryland, fue conocida en adelante como Hermana María. Sirvió a los Oblatos de muchas maneras. Fue superiora general de 1829 a 1832 y, a mediados de la década de 1840, Cuando la hermana Frances murió, tomó su lugar trabajando como empleada doméstica en el Seminario de Santa María. y de 1850 a 1860 fue maestra de novicias de la incipiente orden oblata, y fue llamada cariñosamente Madre María. Los primeros años de vida de la Madre María la habían preparado bien para las turbulencias que siguieron a la muerte del padre Joubert. Sufrió violencia de alma al ser azotada por la pobreza y la injusticia racial. Había una sensación de abandono ante la disminución del número de alumnos y las deserciones de su compañeros y colaboradores más cercanos. Sin embargo, a pesar de todo, la Madre María nunca perdió la fe en la Providencia. La Madre Lange practicó la fe en un grado extraordinario. De hecho, fue su profunda fe la que le permitió perseverar contra todo pronóstico. A sus hermanos y hermanas negros se entregó a sí misma y a sus posesiones materiales hasta quedar vacía de todo menos de Jesús, a quien compartió generosamente con todos siendo testimonio vivo de su enseñanza. La vida de Madre Lange fue larga. Vivió para celebrar las bodas de oro de la orden. Ella es un ejemplo de cómo todos podemos aspirar a serlo. En estrecha unión con su Dios, vivió decepciones y oposición hasta que Dios la llamó a sí el 13 de febrero de 1882.
