Dear Friends in Christ,

This weekend I begin a small part of my summer vacation. I will be travelling with three other priests to Lincoln, New Hampshire for a week followed by two days in Vermont. It is difficult to go away as the clock ticks louder and louder but I think the break is necessary and important. Father Yvon will be home on Sunday afternoon and will be here for the rest of the summer.

It was a great pleasure for me to welcome Msgr. Jack Bracken, our new Temporary Administrator, to our parish this past Tuesday. Over the next few weeks Msgr. Bracken will be meeting with the priests and parish staff to plan for the new parish year. I know that his presence here will be a great blessing for our parish. As I have always said, our parish is spiritually alive, but financially stressed. We have trouble each month meeting our payroll and paying our regular utility bills. Our collection is good, but it does not meet our expenses. One of the greatest challenges that we face is that over 70% of our people still contribute \$1.00 on Sundays. In order to survive we need to change the mindset of our people who think that \$1.00 is enough to give to support our parish. Unfortunately it is not enough. This year our budget is once again a deficit budget. Msgr. Bracken will face, with the parish council and the finance council, the challenge of making more cuts to the services we provide as a parish. It is a difficult decision to make. Many parishioners ask me "What can we do to turn our financial situation around?" My response is always the same. I ask three questions: 1. Are you registered in the parish and do you use your envelopes? 2. Have you tried to increase your Sunday offertory gift every year? 3. Do you make a contribution to the Annual Catholic Appeal which supports our parish and the work of the entire diocese? These areas are key. We can't leave the work to others. This is our parish. It's up to us to put ourselves on a path of financial stability. Please think about these three questions and encourage other parishioners to do the same.

During the month of July the parish was forced to cancel the shuttle bus service that we have been providing for many years that would bring parishioners to church from the 7/11 buildings. 7/11 is now called The Sand Castle. In years past we would have 12-15 parishioners come on the van to the 8:15 A.M. Mass. In recent months that number was rapidly declining. I am concerned for two reasons. First of all we know that there are many Catholics living at 7/11. Some of them are not able to go out on their own, but many are. Why are they not coming to church? I have celebrated Mass there many times and there has always been a good crowd of people. Where are they now? My second concern is how do we find them? There are so many parishioners who are not connected to the parish for many reasons. Recently I was speaking to a woman who told me she stopped coming to church because no one had called her when she was ill. I felt terrible. I asked her did

one of the one's I know I don't have is ESP. Please let us know if you are ill or in the hospital or experiencing difficulties of any kind so that we can be there for you. We are also in need of volunteers who would be willing to pick up people at 7/11 on Sundays and bring them to church and back. It does not have to be every week. If you would like to help with this special ministry please contact St. Mary's Rectory Office.

Our parish is in need of some bi-lingual adults who would be willing to volunteer 3 hours a week to assist in the rectory office. This week St. Gertrude's Office will officially close and all parish business will be conducted from St. Mary Star of the Sea. With the closing of the office at St. Gertrude's also comes the retirement of Mrs. Lucy Morales after many years of faithful service. Lucy has been a generous and devoted volunteer in our parish for many years. She has been of great help to me and to Father Brendan as well. In your name I thank her for her years of service. Mrs. Carmen Montero will now be working full time at St. Mary's office from 8:30 A.M. till 3:00 P.M. Estebana Nino will also be leaving our staff for personal reasons. Estebana has been a generous friend and volunteer for so many years as well. Though she is leaving the office staff she will still be involved in all of her regular parish activities. I am grateful to Lucy and Estebana for all that they do for our parish!

This week Deacon Mike will begin the CARES Program as part of the English Prayer Group's Tuesday night series. There will be an opportunity to pray the rosary followed by some faith sharing based on the Catechism of the Catholic Church. These Tuesday evenings will begin at 7:00 P.M. and all are welcome. Please bring your rosary beads and a copy of the Catechism of the Catholic Church if you have one. If not, Deacon Mike has copies available for sale. I know that this new initiative will be a great blessing for our parish. Please join us!

Recently I found out that one of our former teachers in St. Mary Star of the Sea School, Mr. Michael Krumholz, had a CD released that is available on iTunes and Amazon.com. Mr. K. left teaching to pursue a music career and he is doing well. You can Google him under his stage name of "Mike Krum." His CD is excellent.

Queridos amigos en Cristo,

Este fin de semana empiezo una pequeña parte de mi vacación del verano. Viajare con tres sacerdotes a Lincoln, New Hampshire por una semana seguido por dos días en Vermont. Es difícil irme de vacaciones ahora que no me queda mucho tiempo pero pienso que esta vacación es necesaria y importante. El Padre Yvon volverá el domingo por la tarde y estará aquí por el resto del verano. Tuve el gran placer de darle la bienvenida al Monseñor Jack Bracken, nuestro nuevo administrador temporario, a nuestra parroquia el Martes pasado. Las próximas semanas el Monseñor Bracken se reunirá con los sacerdotes y trabajadores de la parroquia para planear el nuevo año parroquial. Yo se que su presencia aquí será una gran bendición para nuestra parroquia. Como yo siempre he dicho, nuestra parroquia esta viva espiritualmente, pero estresada financieramente. Tenemos problemas cada mes en juntar dinero para de nuestra nómina y el pago de nuestras facturas de servicios públicos regulares. Nuestra colección es buena, pero no cumple con nuestros gastos. Uno de los mayores retos que enfrentamos es que más del 70% de nuestra gente todavía contribuye \$ 1.00 los domingos. Para poder sobrevivir tenemos que cambiar la mentalidad de nuestra gente que piensa que \$1.00 es suficiente para darle a la parroquia. Desafortunadamente no es suficiente. Nuestro presupuesto este año otra vez es uno de déficit. El Monseñor Bracken enfrentara, junto el consejo pastoral y el consejo de financiamiento, el desafío de hacer mas recortes a los servicios que la parroquia ofrece. Es una decisión difícil. Muchos parroquianos me preguntan "Que puedo hacer para cambiar la situación financiera?" Mi respuesta es siempre la misma. Pregunto tres cosas: 1. ¿Esta registrado en la parroquia y usa sus sobres? 2. ¿Ha aumentado su donación semanal cada año? 3. ¿Hace una contribución a la Campaña Católica Anual que ayuda nuestra parroquia y el otro trabajo de la diócesis? Estas son las áreas claves. No podemos dejarles el trabajo a otros. Esta es nuestra parroquia. Es nuestro trabajo de ponernos en un camino de estabilidad financiera. Favor de pensar en estas tres preguntas y dígame a los otros parroquianos que hagan lo mismo. Durante el mes de Julio la parroquia tuvo que cancelar el servicio de bus que por muchos años ofrecimos a los parroquianos que venían de los edificios 7/11. 7/11 ahora se llama el Sand Castle. Antes teníamos entre 12 a 15 parroquianos que venían en la van para la misa de las 8:15am. Los últimos meses esos números empezaron a bajar demasiado rápido. Estoy preocupado por dos razones. Primero por que sabemos que hay muchos católicos viviendo en esos edificios. Varios de ellos no pueden salir solos, pero la mayoría si pueden. Porque no vienen a la Iglesia? He celebrado misa ahí muchas veces y siempre atiende un grupo grande. Adonde están ahora? Mi segunda preocupación es como los encontramos? Hay muchos parroquianos que no están conectados a la Iglesia por muchas razones. Recientemente estaba hablando con una mujer quien me dijo que dejo de venir a la Iglesia porque nadie la llamo cuando estaba enferma. Me sentí terrible. Le pregunte si ella le dijo a alguien. Dijo que no. Todos tenemos muchos regalos pero uno de ellos que yo se que no tengo es el poder de leer la mente. Favor de dejarnos saber si usted esta enfermo o en el hospital o teniendo dificultades de cualquier tipo así podemos estar ahí por usted. También necesitamos voluntarios para venir a recoger personas de los

edificios 7/11 los Domingos y traerlos devuelta. No tiene que ser cada fin de semana. Si le gustaría ayudar con este ministerio especial favor de contactar la oficina de Sta. María. Nuestra parroquia necesita algunos adultos que son bilingües quienes estén dispuestos de voluntariamente ayudar en la rectoría 3 horas durante la semana. Esta semana la oficina de Sta. Gertrudis se cierra y todos los asuntos parroquiales serán conducidos desde Sta. María. Con esto también viene el retiro de la señora Lucy Morales después de muchos años de servicio a la parroquia. Lucy ha sido una generosa y fiel voluntaria en nuestra parroquia por muchos años. Ella me ha ayudado a mí y al Padre Brendan también. En su nombre le doy gracias a ella por sus años de servicio. La señora Carmen Montero ahora estará trabajando desde Sta. María desde las 8:30am hasta las 3:00pm. Estebana Nino también dejara la rectoría por razones personales. Estebana ha sido una amiga generosa y una voluntaria por muchos años. Aunque se va de la oficina igual siguiera involucrada en todas sus actividades regulares en la parroquia. Le doy gracias a Lucy y Estebana por todos lo que han hecho por nuestra parroquia. Esta semana el Diacono Mike empieza el programa CARES como parte de la serie de los martes dada por el grupo de oración de Ingles.
